

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need a visa and a passport for Haiti?

Yes, you will need a passport, visas are not required for short-term travel to Haiti. If you do not have a passport, please order one from your local post office.

2. What paperwork is required to complete registration? Each person is required to submit a waiver, medical/ pastoral release, and a copy of your passport photo page.

3. Will Lott Carey make flight arrangements? Yes, the cost does include your flight from Ohio. If the cost is comparable, flights will be made from your local airport, otherwise there may be additional charges.

4. Do I need to purchase insurance? Lott Carey has included medical travel insurance in the cost.

5. Do I need immunizations? Yes, immunizations and malaria medications are recommended. Check with the Center for Disease Control website for immunization requirements and recommendations.

6. What about packing and getting ready for travel? Orientation will be provided to prepare you spiritually, emotionally and to also give you insight into logistical matters such as: packing, transportation, lodging, meals and etc.

7. Where will we stay while in Haiti? At a moderate air-conditioned hotel, sharing two to a room.

8. How do I make payments or receive donations towards my trip? Payments can be made online at www.aabmc.org or checks/ money orders by mail to payable to Lott Carey.

Once again, tragedy has hit Haiti. The rains from Tropical Storm Erika caused a mudslide, on August 29, in the community of Carries. Thirty-seven (37) homes were destroyed, leaving many people homeless. The purpose of this trip is to work alongside the Mission of Grace community to build a sustainable Carries and assist in helping people to rise again.

There are opportunities for ministry (sharing the Gospel, teaching Bible study and Vacation Bible School) and service at the school (teaching English or music lessons), medical clinic, caring for the children at the orphanage, sharing and caring for the elderly, nurturing teen girls and boys, vocational training at the men's transition center (electrical, plumbing, or etc.) or home making skills (knitting, sewing, crocheting, or etc.).

Your presence and service will be a witness to Christ love and compassion for the people. Expect a closer relationship with the Lord, knowing 'that which you have done for the least of these my brethren, you have done unto the Lord' Matthew 25:40.
