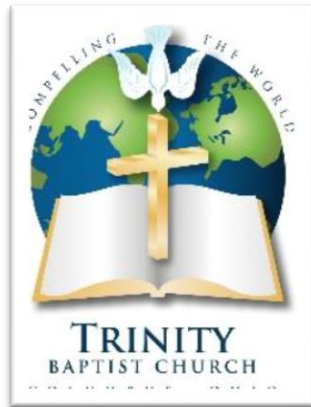

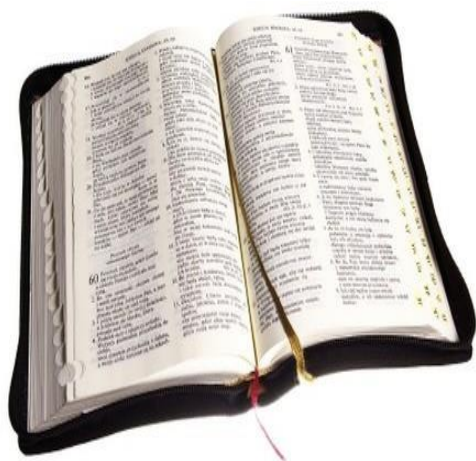
Virtual Vacation Bible School (VBS)
