# 1. WE HAVE THE ASSURANCE OF SALVATION

I John 5:11-12

<sup>11</sup> And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. <sup>12</sup> Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

# Scripture of Assurance

Romans 10:9-13

If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. <sup>11</sup> As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.”<sup>[e]</sup> <sup>12</sup> For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, <sup>13</sup> for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

## Romans 5:8


⁸ But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

# Sin Separates Us...




Our Efforts fail...

# We Do Not Have the Ability to Connect...




# What has God done to bring us to himself?
