

A STANDING OVATION

Throughout our lifetime, we have attended an event whether a concert, theater play, musical performance, or an experience which moved us to tears. Either experience we've had, it has caused us to rise out of our seats, put our hands together in a continuous clapping motion, and raise our voices to display our approval and appreciation for what we witnessed.

We have now arrived at the day Christian's celebrate Palm Sunday. This day is the arrival of Jesus in our lives. It is the celebration of positivity and happiness. Palms are waving in the air, tears are flowing, people are clapping, others have their heads down to show honor, some are pushing forward in the crowd because everyone is wanting to get a glimpse of Jesus.
