

academic excellence, and community engagement. The Pillars of the organization are Leadership, Empowerment, Adaptability, and Discipline (LEAD). The LEAD with Purpose Summer Academy for Black Girls works with Black girls ages 12-16.

The program is offered annually in July. The dates are July 1-31 with a mandatory orientation in June and graduation in August. Participants will demonstrate an increase in healthy behavior, affinity toward leadership roles, years. personal resilience, and soft skill attainment. The goal is for no less than 80% of participants to complete the program with the majority developing reciprocal bonds. Upon completion of Academy, each graduate receives a \$500 stipend. In the summer of 2023, 19 girls completed the program and 8 peer ambassadors completed the ambassador program. Three girls were awarded ipads for top essay submission. Trips included the African-American Museum in Wilberforce Ohio, visits to two Universities and a visit to the Ohio Statehouse. Girls completed over 125 hours of personal and professional development.



Over 150 school children were blessed by our back-to-school give-away.




