Kwanzaa, A Celebration of Culture: December 26 - January 1

Kwanzaa is a time for families and communities to come together to remember the past and to celebrate African American culture. As an African American and Pan-African holiday celebrated by millions throughout the world African community, Kwanzaa brings a cultural message which speaks to the best of what it means to be African and human in the fullest sense. Given the profound significance Kwanzaa has for African Americans and indeed, the world African community, it is imperative that an authoritative source and site be made available to give an accurate and expansive account of its origins, concepts, values, symbols and practices.

Created in 1966 by Maulana Ron Karenga, Kwanzaa celebrates history, values, family, community and culture. The



The ideas and concepts of Kwanzaa are expressed in the Swahili language, one of the most widely spoken languages in Africa. Families and community organize activities around the Nguzo Saba, the seven principles which form its core were drawn from communitarian values found throughout the African continent. These principles are: Umoja (Unity), Kujichagulia (Self-Determination), Ujima (Collective Work and Responsibility), Ujamaa (Cooperative Economics), Nia (Purpose), Kuumba (Creativity), and Imani (Faith). Kwanzaa gets its name from the Swahili phrase, "matunda ya kwanza" and is rooted in first fruit celebrations which are found in cultures throughout Africa both in ancient and modern times.


